Guidelines for Abstract & Full Paper Submission

Abstract Submission

- Word Limit: 200–250 words
- Font: Times New Roman, 12 pt, single spacing
- Format: Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)
- Content:
 - Title of the paper (Centre, Bold, 14 pt.)
 - Name(s) of Author(s), Designation, Institutional Affiliation, and Email ID
 - Keywords (4–6)

Abstract should clearly indicate the Background, Objectives, Methodology, Key Findings and Relevance to the Conference Theme.

- Word Limit: 4000–5000 words (including References)
- Font Spacing: Times New Roman, 12 pt. 1.5 Spacing, Justified Alignment
- Margins: 1 inch on all sides
- File Format: Microsoft Word (.doc or .docx)

- Abstract (repeated)
