Developmental Challenges in Northeast India: A Mizoram Context

Abstract:

This article is meant to study the role of state and non-state actors that contributed for the governance and developmental process in the Northeast India in general and Mizoram in particular. Discoursing a few responses of the governmental agencies, the article has focused on nongovernmental players that were engaged in the developmental process. In contrast to the role that non-state actors like the civil society played in the mainland India, their participation in the North East India is remarkable.
