The Departments of Agri-Business Management & Food Technology, Computer Applications, History & Archaeology and Horticulture were sanctioned in 2010. Department of Forestry and Department of Social Work were also established in the campus recently. The total strength of PG students in the campus is 500 and total number of PhD scholars in the campus is 100. NEHU, Tura Campus was established to fulfil the needs of students pursuing higher education within the region and to ensure that opportunities for post graduation education reached the farthest corners of the state. To that end, Tura Campus has fulfilled its objective of being a premier institution for students and scholars from other parts of the state who sought and continue to seek quality higher education.
