Annual Report 2019-2020

The Indian Council of Social Science Research, North-Eastern Regional Centre (ICSSR-NERC) was established in May 1977 in collaboration with North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) at Shillong to review, promote, encourage, assist and coordinate social science research in the Northeastern region of India and it has completed 40 years of its existence and its services to the scholars. In this volume we present a brief history and an account of the various activities performed by the NERC during 2019-2020.

Introduction

The Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR) was set-up by the Government of India on 12th May 1969 as an autonomous organization on the recommendation of the Committee for Social Science Research (CSST) under the Chairmanship of Professor V.K.R.V. Rao, while he was a member of the Planning Commission in-charge of Education. From its inception ICSSR was conceived as a premier national agency expanding social science formulation. In pursuance of the above objectives and as part of its programme of decentralizing administration and board basing social science research, ICSSR took, in the past, a considered decision to set-up regional centres all over the country.

At present, there are six Regional Centres of the ICSSR, namely Eastern Regional Centre at Kolkata, Southern Centre at Hyderabad, Western Regional Centre at Mumbai, North-Western Regional Centre at Chandigarh and Northern Regional Centre at New Delhi.

The North-Eastern Regional Centre of the Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR-NERC) was established on March 2, 1977 in collaboration with North-Eastern Hill University (NEHU) at Shillong to review, promote, encourage, assist an coordinate social science research in the north-eastern region of India and it has completed 43 years of its existence and its services to the scholars. It was established with the following aims:

- (i) to act as the agent of the ICSSR within the region;
- (ii) to act as the representative of the social scientists of the region and to bring their ideas and problems to the ICSSR.

- (iii) To provide a platform for the social scientists of the region to come together for formation of social science research; and
- (iv) To serve as the link between the social scientists of the region and the national and international community of the social scientists.

The ICSSR-NERC covers all the eight States of the region – Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Sikkim and Tripura. Its main objectives are :

- i. To render essential bibliographical and documentation service for research work;
- To organize or to assist the organization of seminars, workshops, research methodology courses, conferences etc at different universities, colleges and other institutions in the North-East;
- iii. To award study grant for research scholars in order to collect data in the libraries in north-east;
- iv. To organize lectures by distinguished scholars on issues pertaining to the northeast India; and
- v. To disseminate information about the programme of the ICSSR.

During 43 years of its valuable services for the development of social science research in the north-eastern region of India, the Centre has been pursuing its activities with renewed zeal and has sponsored many academic programmes and research all over the region. Besides, it has also taken up various research activities itself that are pertinent for the region. It has several publications to its credit. It has also been publishing UGC CARE listed bi-annual journal *Man and Society* for last sixteen years and unique *News on North East India* (NNE) paper clippings which acts as information handbook for researchers.
